



## **RE-OPENING OF THE EMBASSY OF THE UNITED REPUBLIC OF TANZANIA, WASHINGTON, D.C**

The United Republic of Tanzania to the United States of America and Mexico, is full-fledged open with effect from **Monday, June 28<sup>th</sup>, 2021**, after a long closure due to the prevailing **COVID-19** pandemic. All Consular Services will now be provided on **Mondays to Thursdays from 9:30 a.m – 12:30 p.m.**

All passport applicants must complete all the required online procedures before contacting the Embassy for submission and appointments. Biometrics and picture appointments can be booked online through [ppappt@tanzaniaembassy-us.org](mailto:ppappt@tanzaniaembassy-us.org) or call 202-884-1080. No walk-in will be accommodated.

All applicants who have received appointment confirmation email should read and take note of all requirements before visiting the Embassy.

Applicants are required to adhere all **COVID-19** best practice guidelines, including:

- Social distancing;
- Wear face mask;
- Temperature screening;
- Washing and/or sanitize hands upon admission, before and after biometric capture; and
- Remain seated on the designated area waiting for direction from Embassy Staff.

**Please do not come to your appointment if you have been exposed to COVID-19 within the days or you have any symptoms of COVID-19.**
